| <b>Expedited Application Process</b><br>Optional for either a initial applicant or a certified participant's Scope Change. Includes moving to the top of the list for reviews (eligibility and corrective action request review), the Stage 1 audit, and the site audit will be conducted within 60 days of the Stage 1 completion. | <b>Certification &amp; Endorsement Scope Change (Optional for participants only)</b><br>Applicable when a participant requests an additional certification or endorsement. | <b>Pre-Assessment/Gap Analysis (Optional)</b><br>The pre-assessment is conducted to assist a company considering certification or needing to improve its quality management system (QMS).  |  |                  |                   | \$3,000        |

| <b>Additional Site Audit</b><br>Applicable as a follow-up to a renewal, initial, appeal, or complaint audit, and it may be required for the participant or applicant's certification to continue or be granted. | <b>Eligibility Review Refund</b><br>If the review is not successfully completed or the application process ends after it is completed, the applicant's fee will be refunded minus the "review fee" to the right.   |  |                  |                   | \$1,000        |
